# 1. Communication / Letters that addressed key issues

Segment 1 update sequence by date: 2 December

# Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> December

A meeting of the Board of Trade was called by DGFT on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2020 which was chaired by Shri Piyush Goyal, Minister of Commerce, Govt. of India wherein the associations Presidents/Heads were invited to give their inputs/suggestions on the forthcoming Foreign Trade Policy 2021-26. This was a marathon meeting of about 5 hours. IATO gave its inputs in advance through SEPC requesting the following:-

#### 1. Service Export from India Scheme for the Tour Operators

- To continue SEIS for the tour operators
- Pending SEIS for Financial Year 2019-20 to be announced
- Increase of SEIS percentage in Foreign Trade Policy 2021-26 to 15% during off season and 10% during season
- 2. Under EPCG Scheme requirement of incremental Foreign Exchange Earnings to be removed for import of Vehicles.
- 3. Value based tourist inflow incentives for MICE Tourism to be provided
  - 4. Tax Refund for Tourists (TRT) Scheme on shopping

Since agenda of the meeting could not be completed, associations who did not get a chance to speak of make presentation, were asked to submit their inputs/suggestions in advance to discuss the same in another meeting to be called on 7<sup>th</sup> December 2020. Accordingly, IATO submitted its inputs/suggestions to Additional Director General Foreign Trade. IATO also submitted its suggestions to President FIEO and DDG, SEPC requesting them to support IATO in raising these issues with the Ministry of Commerce/DGFT.

# > Pending important issues of the industry – need your kind and urgent attention

IATO requested Mrs. Meenakshi Sharma, Director General (Tourism) to kindly apprise it with the latest position on its recommendations on

- 1. <u>Revision in MDA Guidelines</u> Draft of the MDA was received from the Ministry on 26th June 2020 and IATO gave inputs on 1st July 2020
- 2. Revision in Guidelines for Grant of Recognition by MoT Draft was received from the Ministry on 11th August 2020 and IATO has given its inputs on 18th August 2020

Besides the above, two other two issues related to Ministry of Commerce/Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Home Affairs for which IATO also wrote to the Ministry of Tourism for their help

- I) <u>Increase in SEIS Scrips from 7% to 10%</u> and to be announced urgently for 2019-20 In this regard the last letter of IATO dated 16<sup>th</sup> September addressed to Secretary (Tourism) has also been attached
- II) <u>Restoration of E-Visa and Tourist Visa</u> for survival of tour operators and the tourism industry: The last letter of IATO dated 20<sup>th</sup> November 2020 addressed to Secretary (Tourism) has also been annexed.
