1. Communication / Letters that addressed key issues

Segment 1 update sequence by date:30 April

IATO requested Mrs. Nirmala Sitharaman, Hon'ble Minister for Finance to release SEIS scrips of last financial year 2019-20 for the Tourism Industry as the demand is legitimate as per provision in the foreign trade policy 2015-20.

IATO had made several representations to Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Commerce and PMO and expressed the difficulties the tourism industry was facing since March 2020 due to Covid 19. It hoped that inbound tourism would start soon as situation was improving day by day during till March 2021, but due to second wave of this deadly coronavirus, Covid -19, inbound tourism business was not to start soon

Tour operators, anticipating the SEIS benefits, had already spent the funds for marketing and promotion of tourism to India during 2019-20 and were now facing acute shortage of funds.
